

Regulations of the Urban Game "Secrets of the Shipyard vs. Mysterious Aniołki District"

§1 Administration

1. The organizer of the urban game, further referred to as the "Organizer," is the Scientific CLUB of Spatial Planning of the University of Gdańsk and the Digital Architecture LAB CLUB of the Gdańsk University of Technology in cooperation with the Metropolitan Institute and the Fahrenheit Schools.
2. By organizing the urban game, further referred to as the "Game," we mean the preparation of Checkpoints in the shipyard areas and the Aniołki district in Gdańsk, as well as all other activities aimed at its proper conduct.

§2 Game Objective

1. Education through installations.
2. Promoting a new approach to issues related to getting to know the city, its history, and identity, with particular emphasis on the overpass itself and the immediate surroundings: the shipyard areas and the Aniołki district.
3. Encouraging exploration of Gdańsk's districts from a slightly different perspective.
4. Facilitating social integration on a local and citywide scale.

§3 Game Rules - Course of the Game and Registration

1. The game will take place on May 12th, 2024, in Gdańsk.
2. The game will start and end at the Yellow Viaduct at the entrance from the Katyn Massacre Victims Roundabout.
3. Task cards for participants will be issued from 13:00 to 16:00.
4. Completed cards will be accepted until 18:00.
5. Participants' task is to move between individual Checkpoints and perform the successive tasks described on the task cards.
6. Registrations for the Game are conducted online via Google Forms.
7. The form is available on the Yellow Viaduct website (zolty-wiadukt.pl) and the official Facebook event "Secrets of the Shipyard vs. Mysterious Aniołki District."
8. The registration should include personal data of one person from the team: email address, chosen variant of one of the two paths, and chosen language version of the Game.
9. Registrations will be accepted from April 9th at 10:00 until May 10th at 23:59.
10. Participation in the Game is possible individually or in groups of 2-5 people.
11. Participation in the Game is free and voluntary.

§4 Game Rules - Conditions and Manner of Participation

1. The condition for participation in the game is filling out the registration form and having your own pen/pencil.
2. At least one person in the group must be in legal age of 18 years old.
3. Persons lacking legal capacity and having limited legal capacity, including persons who have reached the age of 13 but have not reached the age of 18, may participate in the Game provided they obtain written consent from a legal guardian or statutory representative.
4. The consent of the legal guardian/statutory representative should include, in particular, consent to participate in the urban game and acceptance of the provisions of these Regulations, including the processing of the participant's personal data by the Organizer. The consent should be delivered to the Organizer on the day of the Game.
5. Game participants cannot be employees and representatives of the Organizer or other entities directly involved in the preparation and conduct of the urban game, as well as their close relatives. Close relatives include ascendants, descendants, siblings, spouses, spouses of siblings, collateral relatives, and people in a guardianship relationship. During the urban game route, participants can only move on foot or by bicycle. Using different means of transport results in disqualification.
6. The urban game takes place in normal city traffic; therefore, participants are asked to exercise special caution and comply with traffic regulations. The Organizer does not provide medical care for persons participating in the urban game. Participants move around the city at their own risk.
7. By participating in the Game, participants assume full legal and civil liability for the entire duration of the Game. In the case of minors, parents/legal guardians are responsible for such people.
8. Each person participating in the urban game should be in good health, enabling participation in the Game.
9. A team, if any of its members do not meet this requirement, will be automatically disqualified from further play.

§5 Urban Game Routes

1. Two thematic paths are planned for participants: shipyard-historical titled "Secrets of the Shipyard" and concerning the history of the Aniołki district titled "Mysterious Aniołki District."
2. The description of individual routes will be provided on the Yellow Overpass website (zolty-wiadukt.pl) and the official Facebook event "Secrets of the Shipyard vs. Mysterious Aniołki District."

§6 Prizes

1. A small material prize is planned for each participant of the urban game.
2. Main prizes are planned for the winners of both paths.
3. The winner/winners will be the person or group that first delivers a correctly filled task card to the finish line of the Game.
4. Additionally, a team that takes the most interesting group photo during the game will be honored.

§7 Final Provisions

1. The Regulations are available for viewing on the Yellow Viaduct website (zolty-wiadukt.pl) and the official Facebook event "Secrets of the Shipyard vs. Mysterious Aniołki District."
2. In matters concerning the course of the urban game not covered by these regulations, the decision lies with the Organizer.
3. The Organizer reserves the right to introduce changes to the regulations.
